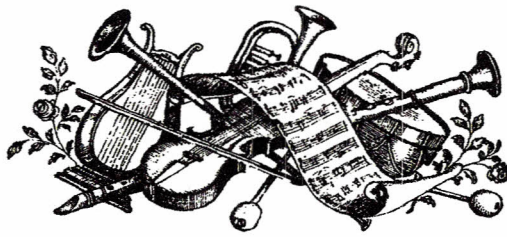


# CHEVY CHASE CONCERTS

Thanks to your generous support we concluded the 40<sup>th</sup> season of musical offerings to the community on May 15 with a performance of the Duruflé *Requiem* and gala reception. What a season it was! We trust that you were as rewarded to experience the artistry of our performers as we were in presenting them.

We are delighted with the new season which is shaping up to be as exciting as our anniversary season. Last year The Commonwealth Brass opened our season. This year The Capitol Woodwind Quintet opens the season on October 30. On November 20 Joann Moorer, Assistant Director of Music at CCPC, holder of music degrees from Indiana University of Pennsylvania and Peabody in Baltimore and Colleague of the American Guild of Organists, will be featured in recital. On December 11 the several musical groups of CCPC will present our traditional Christmas concert. A 6-piece jazz ensemble from Baltimore swings on January 15. On February 19 Andrew York, internationally acclaimed classical guitarist, will appear. The 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Bach Marathon will be March 18. Our season will conclude with a concert by the CCPC Chancel Choir with orchestra on May 20.
