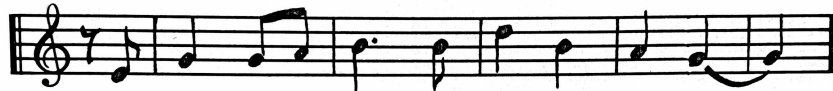
Prayer for Illumination
